## Intensive Learning Activity Week Entrepreneurship Education in Primary Teacher Education, Roskilde Denmark 14-18. May 2018

University College Absalon and The Danish Foundation for Entreprenuership are proud to host the first learning activity week for initial teacher training students. EIPTE, "Entreprenurship In Initial Primary Teacher Education" is a Strategic Partnership funded by the European Union under Erasmus KA2. It presents an outstanding opportunity to learn about entrepreneurship in primary school, and to develop professional teaching competences. The overall purpose of EIPTE is that students at HEI as future primary teachers are capable of creating an entrepreneurial pedagogy and environment in which pupils will have the opportunity to test and develop their entrepreneurial mindsets.

### Target Group for the learning activity week in Denmark

Target Group are students in initial teacher training, especially focusing on primary school teaching. Teachers at teacher training institutions are also welcome and additional content will be added to the basic programme for this group.

### **Program**

The goal for this learning activity week is to create a process, where teacher students will learn and experience entrepreneurial didactics – by creating an entrepreneurial process for pupils in a school.

For five days we will achieve a theoretical and practical understanding of the notion of entrepreneurship and entrepreneurial competences. We will do a lot of practise, present tools, tricks and tips for the students, preparing them to perform reflected teaching that supports entrepreneurial mindsets and competences for their coming primary pupils.

The program is a blend of theory and workshops; an entrepreneurial process that gives a personal and embodied experience for entrepreneurship.

This leads to a session where the participants shall develop and perform a session for real live Danish 3.-6. Grade pupils.

### **Important notice**

EIPTE learning activity weeks are an exclusive opportunity to meet and learn with teacher students in a trans-European setting. The venue is organized in teams, so every participant must notice an obligation to be part of all sessions and activities during the event. In return we guarantee hard work, fun and that participants will be part of an exclusive group of skilled entrepreneurship teachers.



### **Learning Outcomes**

After participation participants:

- Will have a theoretical knowledge on entrepreneurship in a pedagogical context
- Will be able to develop, design, practise and evaluate cycles of lessons that involve entrepreneurship
- Will be able to support and integrate entrepreneurial competences in their daily teaching practise enabling a dual focus (curriculum and EE) through didactical thinking and reflected methodology
- Will be able to critical thinking and reflection on teaching practise in regards to entrepreneurship

### **Practical Information**

The event takes place at University College Absalon situated in Trekroner just outside the municipality of Roskilde DK (and a short 22 minutes train trip to Central Copenhagen).

Your participation will be financed by the EU Strategic Partnership budget, if you are a student or a staff member of the participating organisations. The travel allowance (unit cost) is 180 euros for a distance of up to 499 km, and 275 Euros for a distance of up to 1999 km. You can use this **Distance Calculator:** http://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmusplus/tools/distance\_de.htm.

Each student will receive 330 Euros for accommodation and food. They need to arrive on Sunday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, and they need to depart on May 19<sup>th</sup>. This is important, because the stay will only be funded, if the student stays 5 whole days.

Each staff member will receive 100 Euros per day of stay for accommodation and food.

The price for a lunch in the canteen in Absalon is app. 4 Euros, and the price for the dinner Friday evening in Copenhagen is 7 Euros pr. Person.

### Nice to know:

Currency: We are using Danish kroner (kr) or DKK. You are able to pay with credit card (Visa or MasterCard) almost everywhere. 1 DKK is approx. 0,13 EUR.

You will probably arrive in Copenhagen Airport. It is easy to get to the Central Station (København H) from the airport. 12 minutes by train.

From København H you will find good connections to Roskilde almost every 10 minutes. Travel time is approx. 25 minutes.

Tickets can be bought at DSB (Danish Railways) in the airport or from the red ticket machines in the airport. The price for a single ticket to Roskilde will be 92 DKK (12,5 EUR). A 24-hour ticket costs 150 DKK.

From Roskilde station, you can take a taxi, a bus (203 to Sankt Clara Vej) or walk (20 minutes) to Danhostel. You can use the same ticket in the bus and train.



### Monday - Friday:


From Danhostel to Professionshøjskolen Absalon (University College Absalon) you can take bus 203 at 8:19 (Sankt Clara Vej 48) to the train station. Change to train at 8:45 (towards Østerport), platform 5. Get off at Trekroner station 8:48 (Takes only 3 minutes) Walk 10 min to Professionshøjskolen Absalon. **ONLY cash 24,00 DKK**.

### To the airport:

Take a train from Roskilde to København H and change for a train to the airport. Few trains will go directly. Buy a single ticket in the machine.
